**Statement from Chabad Lubavitch UK**

Chabad Lubavitch UK expresses its deep shock and unequivocal condemnation following the arson attack on Hatzolah North West ambulances.

Hatzolah is a vital, life-saving emergency service whose dedicated volunteers provide rapid medical assistance to all members of the public, regardless of background. Their work embodies the very best of our society, selflessness, compassion and an unwavering commitment to preserving life.

This was not only an act of destruction; it was an attack on a service that protects the entire community. Such actions are profoundly disturbing and have no place in a civilised society.

We stand in full solidarity with Hatzolah North West, its volunteers and all who depend on their care and we pay tribute to their extraordinary dedication and resilience.

As we approach Passover, we are reminded of the words we sing at the Seder in V'hi She'amdah: "This [promise of G-d's protection to Abraham] has stood by our ancestors and by us: for in every generation there arise those who seek our destruction, yet the Holy One, blessed be He, delivers us from their hands." This is not only a memory of the past, but a living truth. The Jewish people endure because our existence is rooted in something eternal and because G-d's promise ensures that light, life and goodness will ultimately prevail.

We urge the authorities to bring those responsible swiftly to justice and to finally confront the hatred behind such acts.

At a time like this, our response must be to increase in acts of goodness and kindness bringing more light into the world. We encourage everyone to volunteer, give charity and actively support Hatzolah North West's emergency response efforts.

If you are Jewish, take this moment to reach out, invite another Jew to your Seder, especially someone who might otherwise be alone and ensure that the message of freedom, faith and continuity is shared and strengthened.
